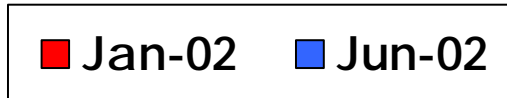
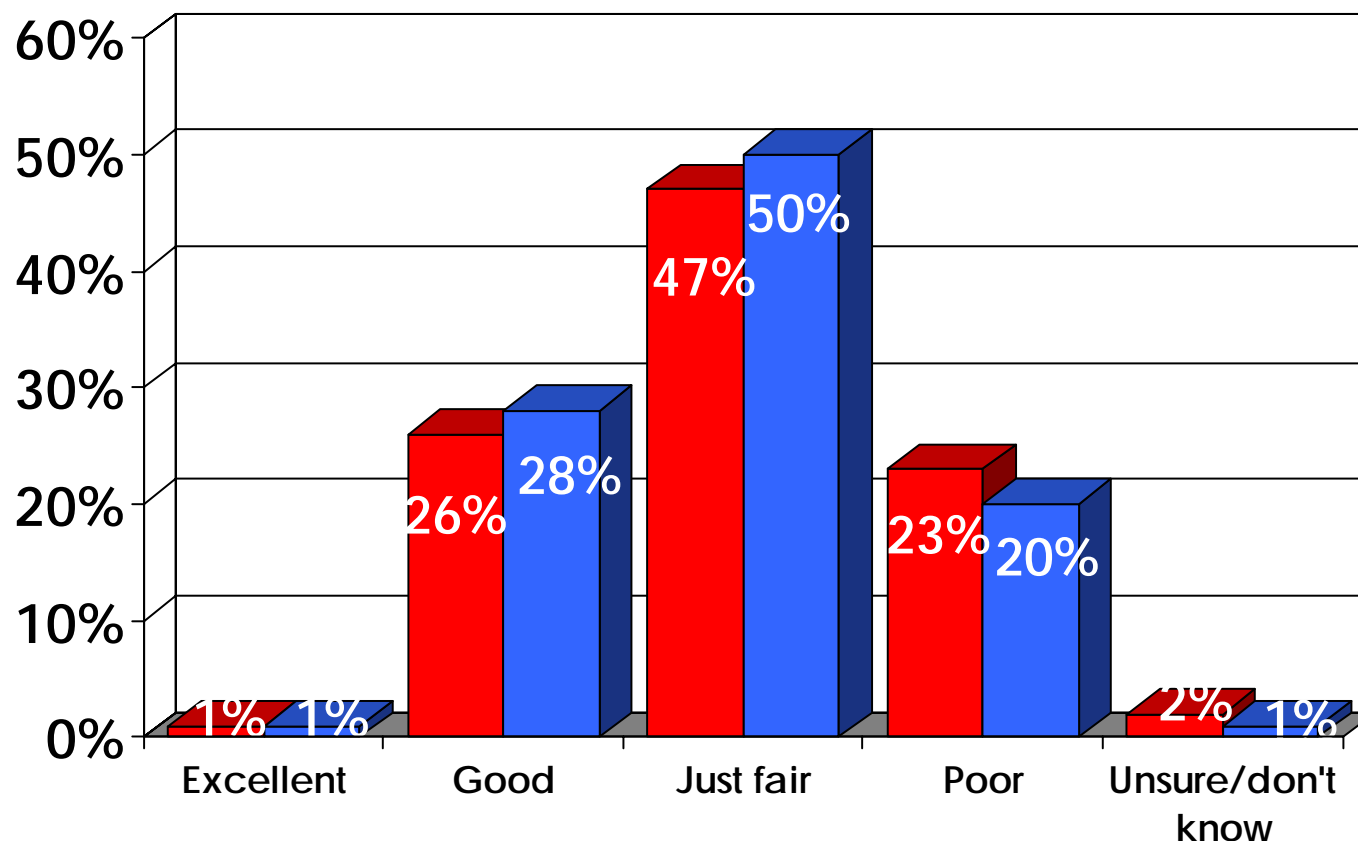
What do you think is the number one problem facing this part of the country today -- that is, what is the problem that you and your family are most concerned about?



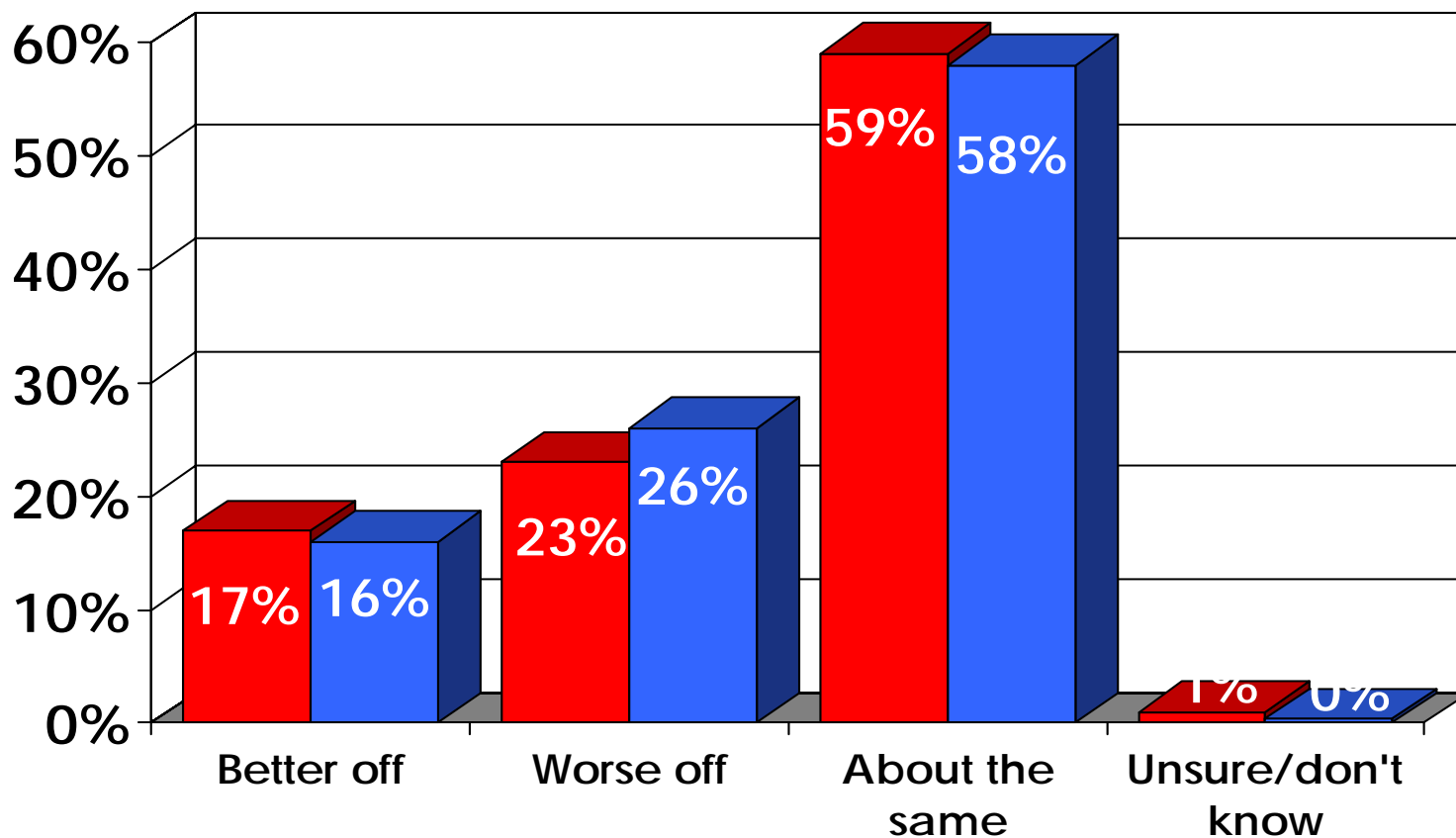
Which party do you think could do a better job of working to solve this problem? Do you think that the Republican Party or the Democratic Party – could do a better job of working to solve this problem?



In thinking about the economy, how would you rate the current state of the economy?

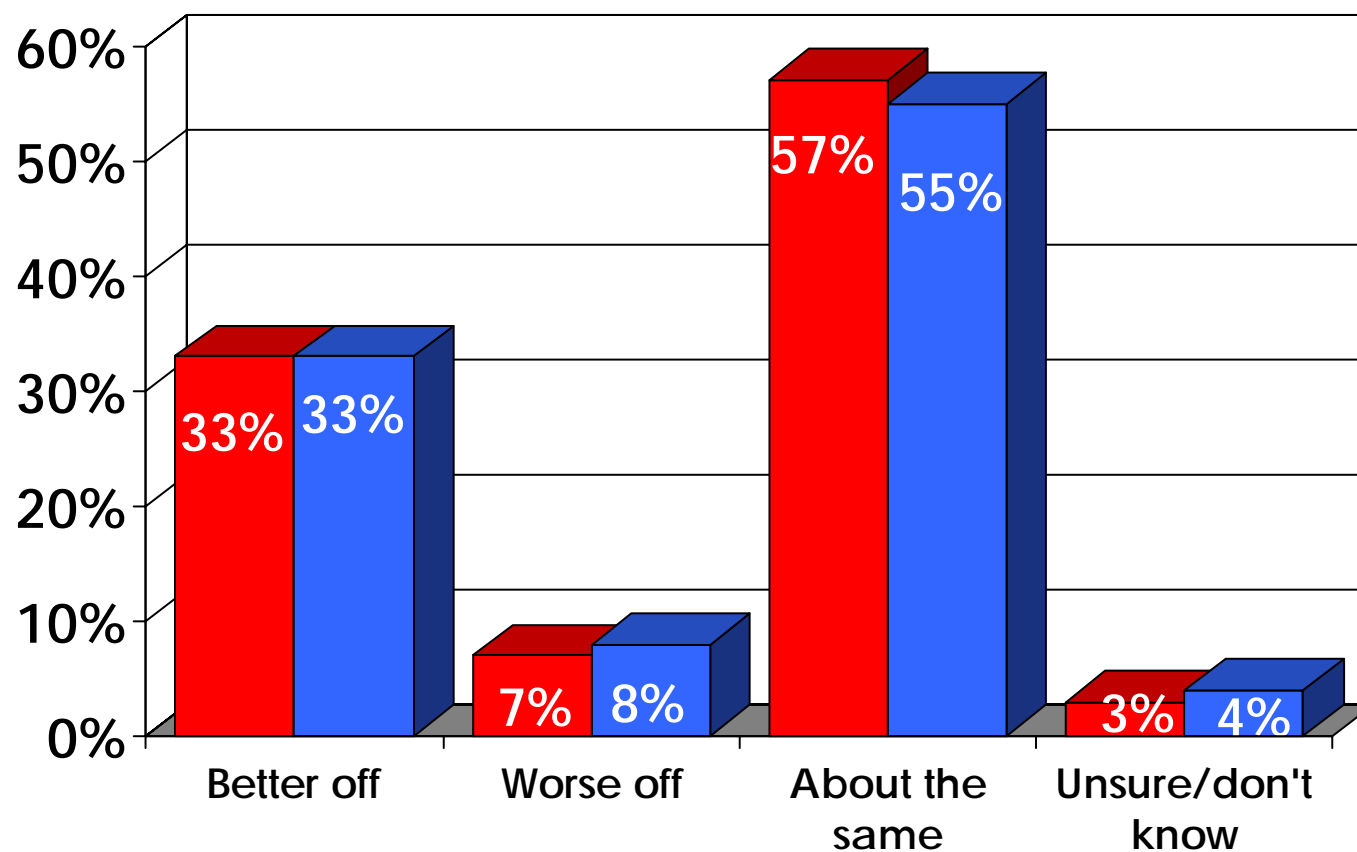

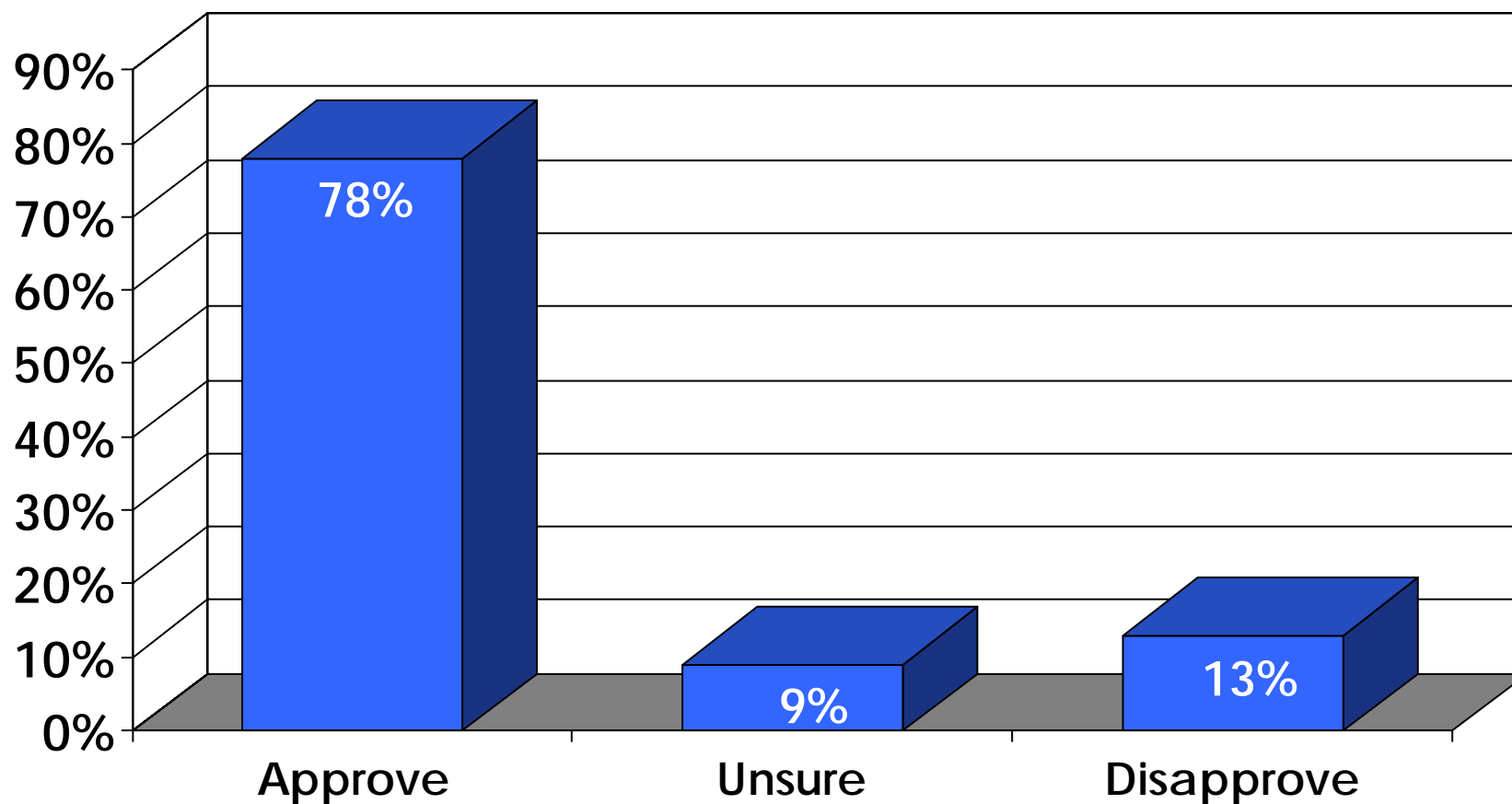

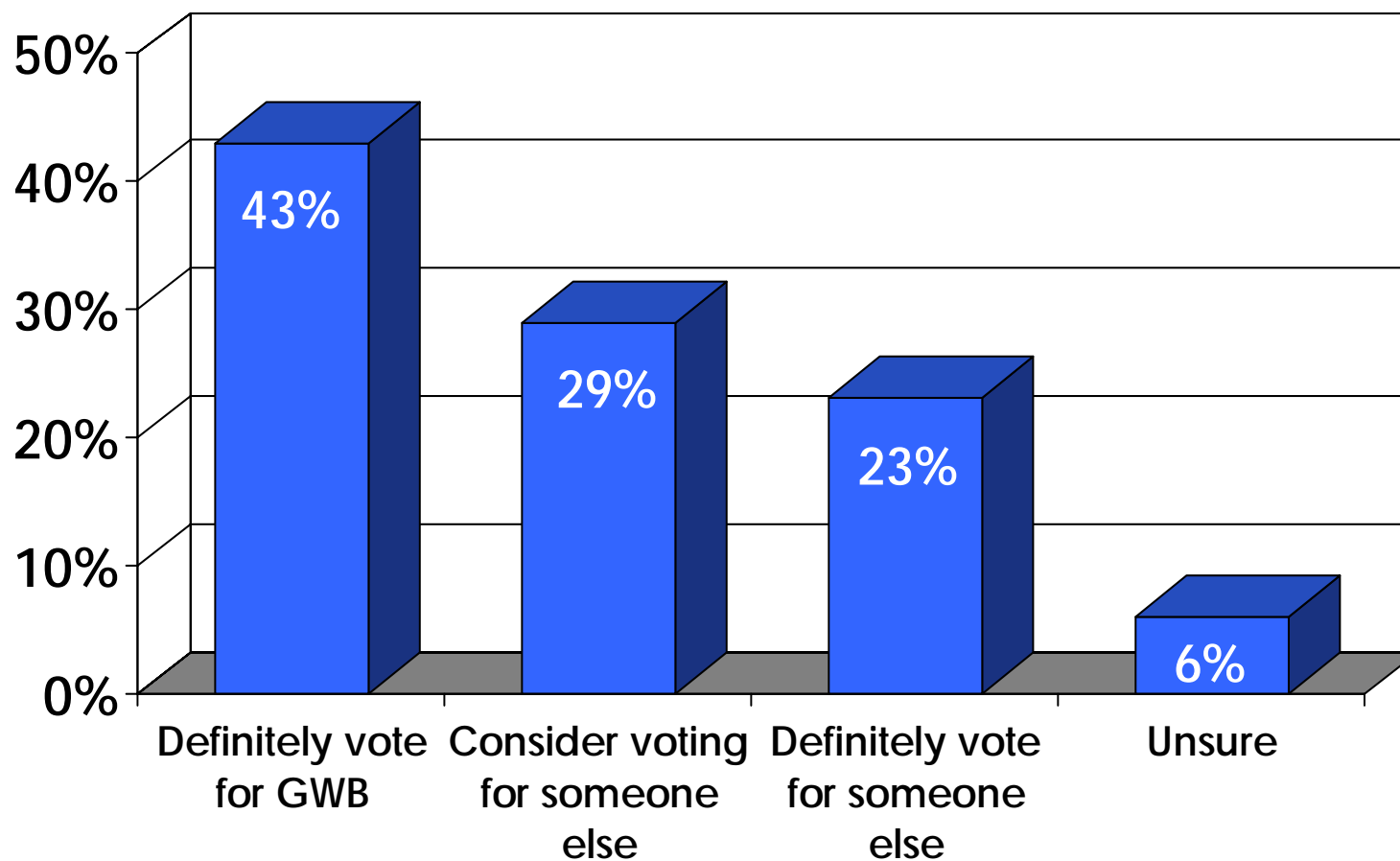

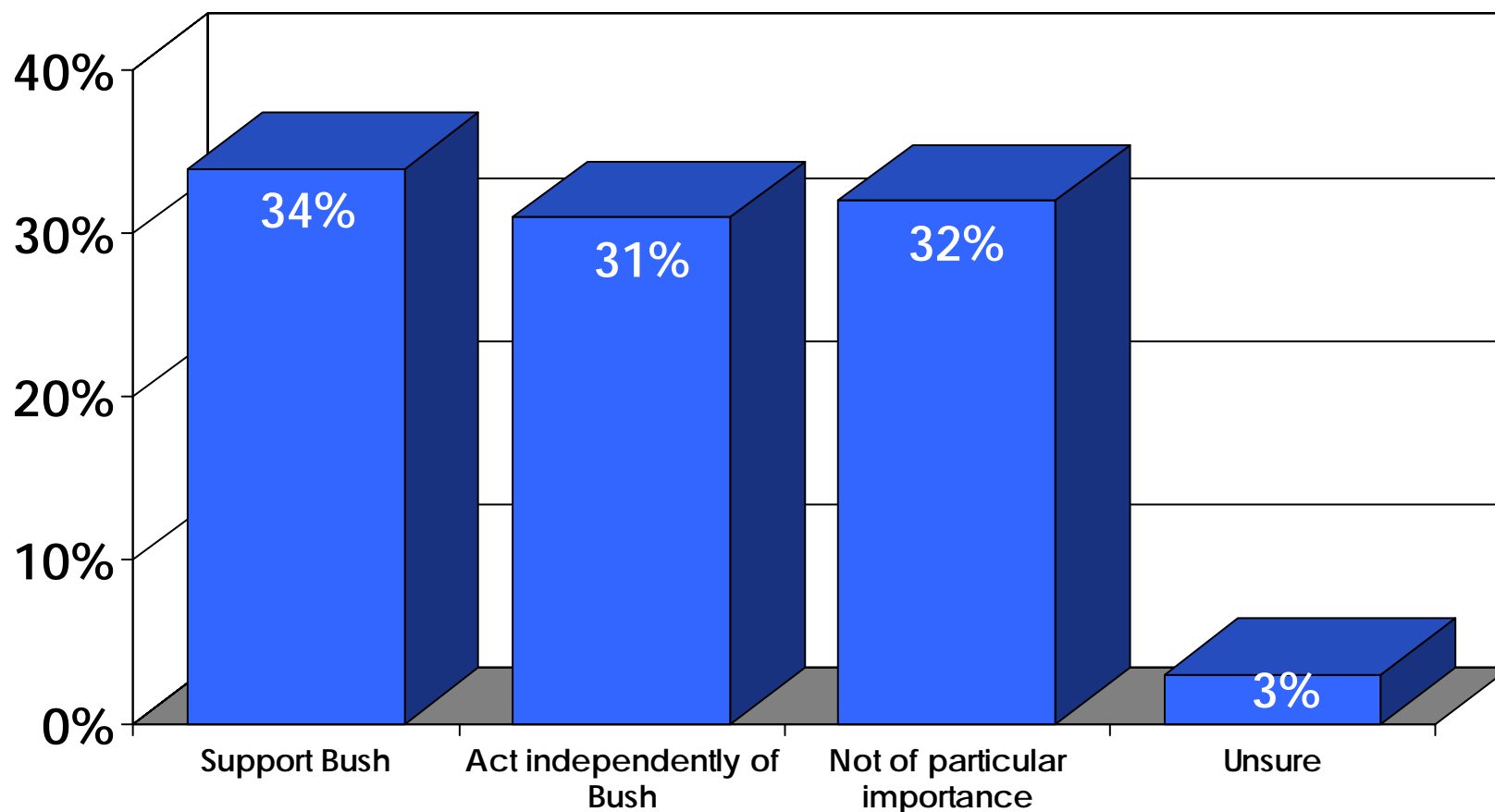
## Do you approve or disapprove of the way the Republicans in Congress are handling their jobs?



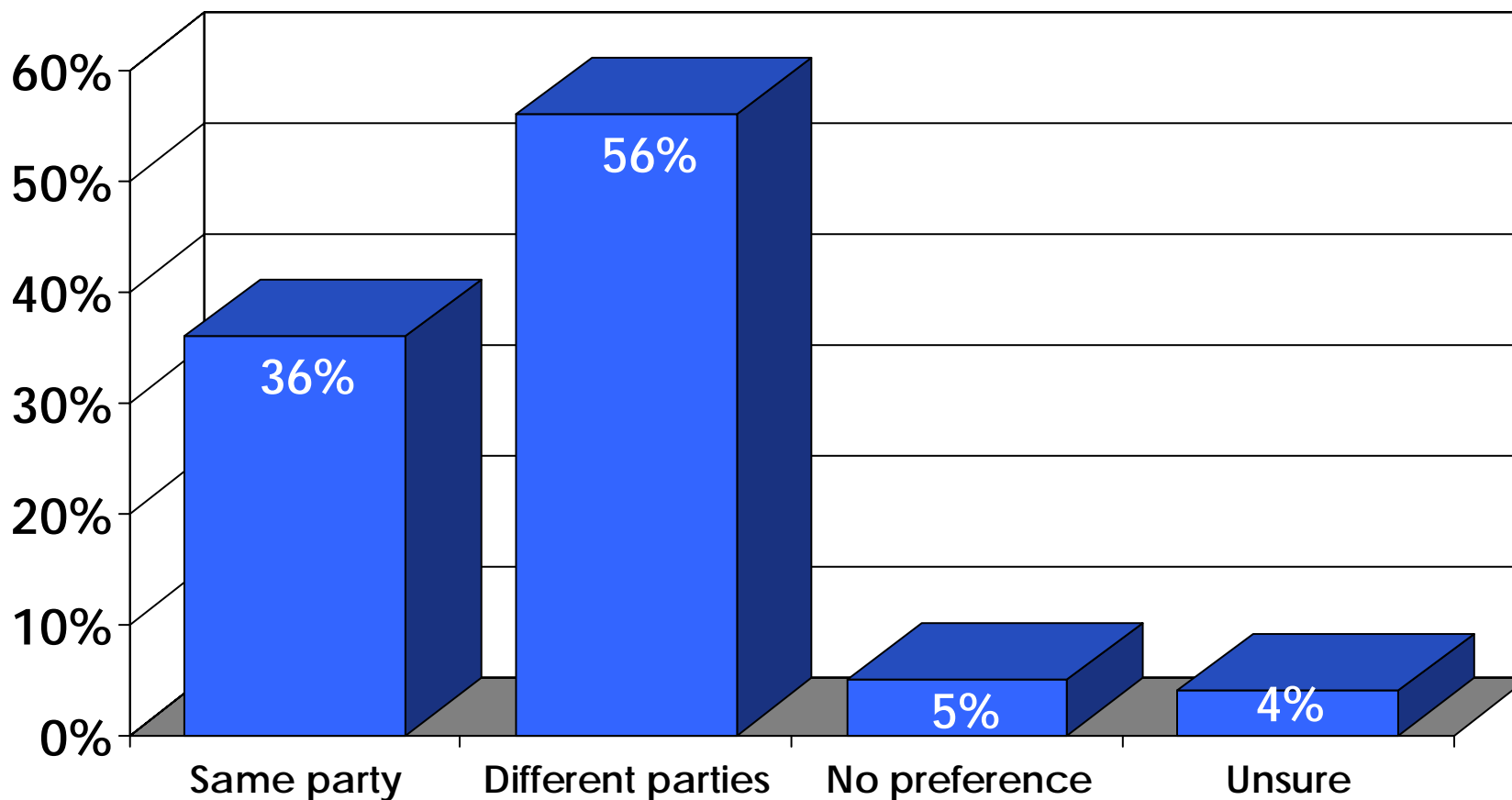

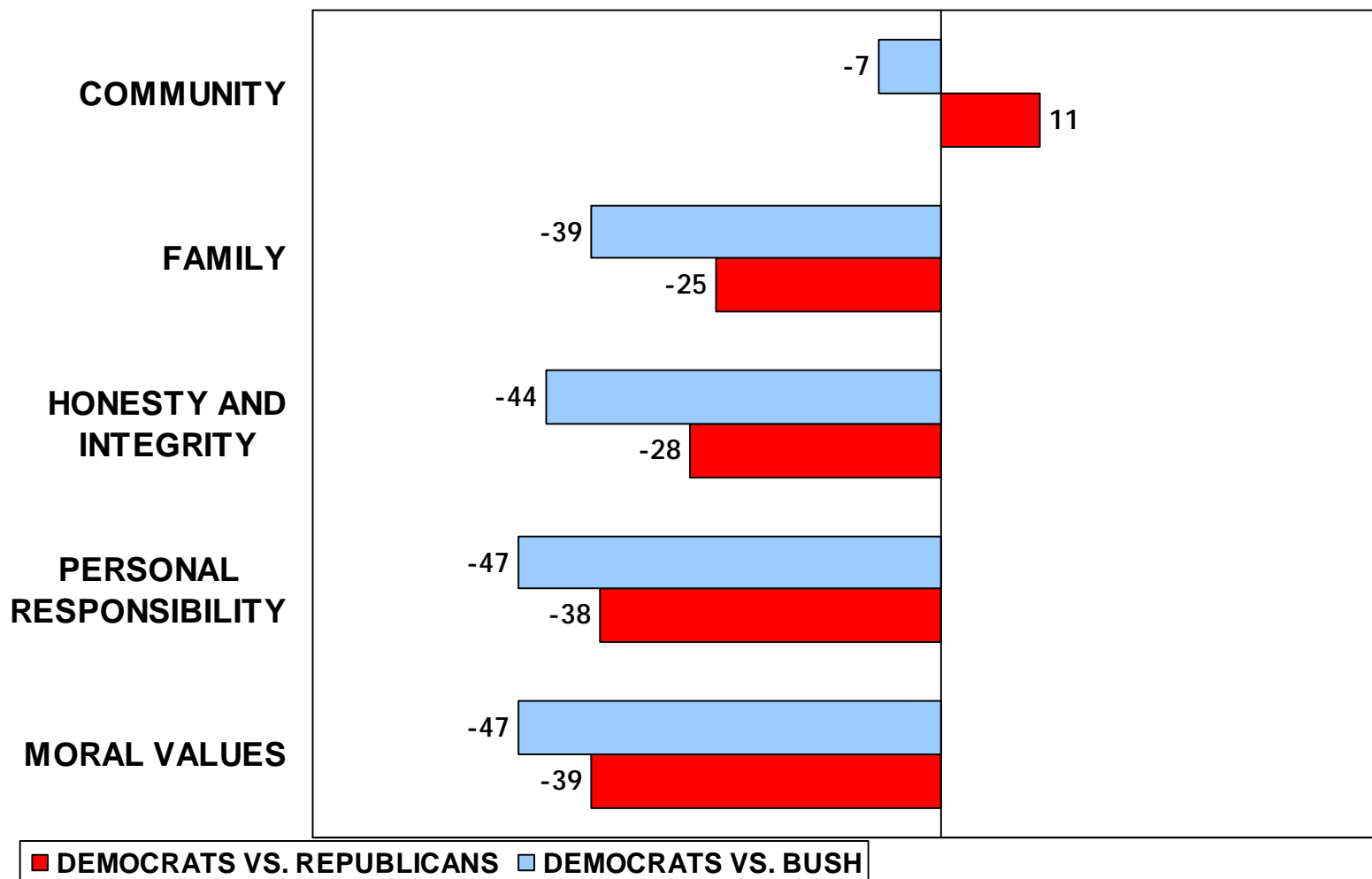

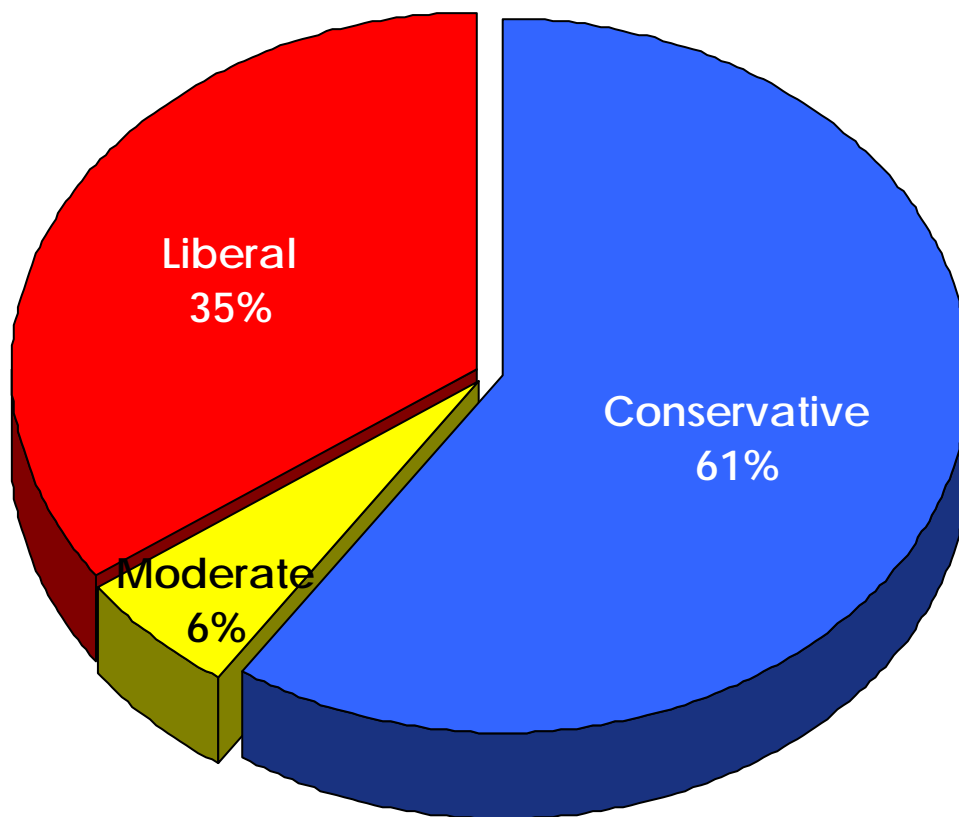
